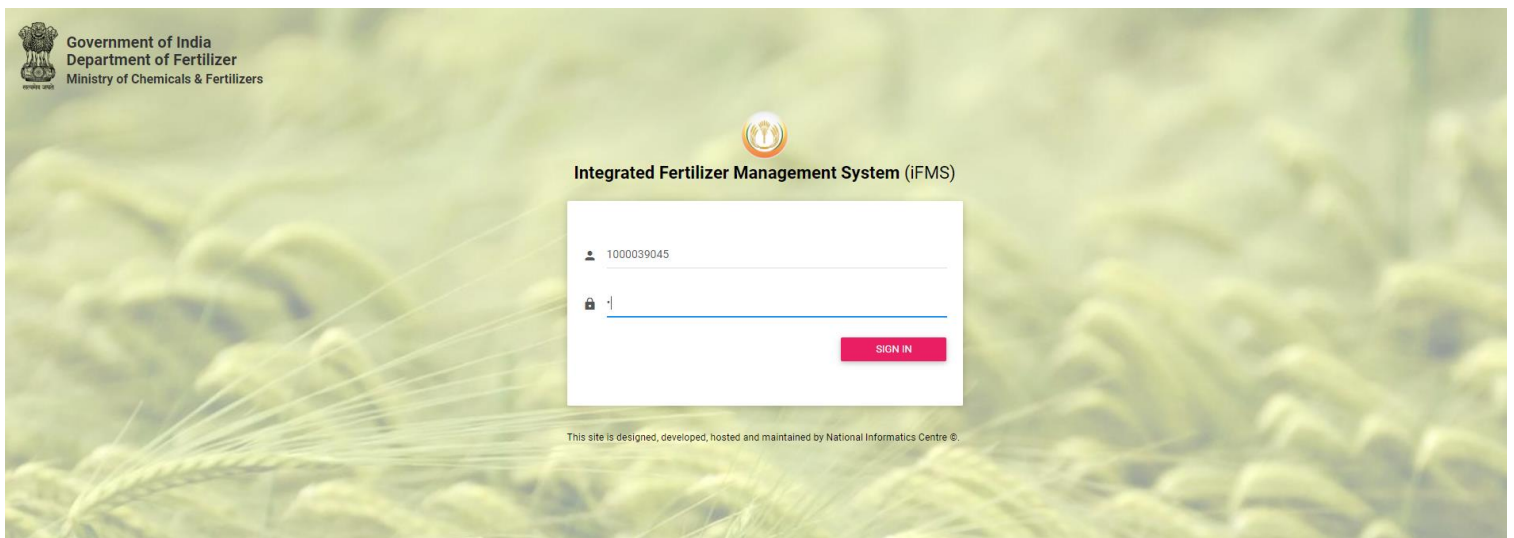



2. On successful login the page will be redirected to the new iFMS application's reset password page. Resetting the password is necessary for accessing the iFMS application (old and new both).


